
Common Core Classroom Activities

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

GRADE 2: When their parents steal the monkey, describe how Billy and Jillian get the monkey back to the zoo?

GRADE 3: Describe Billy. What are some of his character traits? How would you describe Jillian's personality? What do Billy and Jillian do to help return the monkey to the zoo?

<u>CCSS.ELA-Literacy.RL.3.3</u> Describe characters in a story (e.g., their traits, motivations, or feelings) and explain how their actions contribute to the sequence of events.

UNDERSTANDING VOICE

Grade 2: Brainstorm how each character's voice might sound. Practice the voices by reading the first chapter of the book or the <u>Reader's Theater Script</u>. You can find this in the resources index of www.maryamato.com

<u>CCSS.ELA-Literacy.RL.2.6</u> Acknowledge differences in the points of view of characters, including by speaking in a different voice for each character when reading dialogue aloud.
